But for the 200,000-plus kids injured on average each year and the 270 killed since 1998, happiness became a nightmare. BY THE NUMBERS /

262,300 Injuries

There were 262,300 serious toy-related injuries in 2011 and 13 deaths. Asphyxiation (often from choking on toy parts, small balls or balloons) was the leading cause of death, while non-motorized scooters caused the most injuries.

If a toy or part of a toy can pass through a toilet paper tube – approximately 1.25 inches in diameter – don't buy it for a child under age 3, or any child who still puts objects in his/her mouth.
